



In 1996, the Asian Fisheries Social Science Research Network (AFSSRN) became a section of the Asian Fisheries Society (AFS). Its By-laws was ratified in August 2019 following the Joint GAFS and AFSSRN Assembly held during the 12th AFAF Conference in Iloilo City. The AFSSRN objectives are: (1) to promote effective interaction and cooperation among persons involved in fisheries and aquaculture social sciences research; (2) to encourage and promote investigation and advances in knowledge of fisheries and aquaculture social sciences; (3) to focus attention on fisheries and aquaculture social sciences problems by disseminating technical and other information on all aspects of fisheries and aquaculture fisheries and aquaculture social sciences and management; and (4) to promote the proper use of fisheries and social aquaculture sciences research practices and results in the Asia-Pacific
